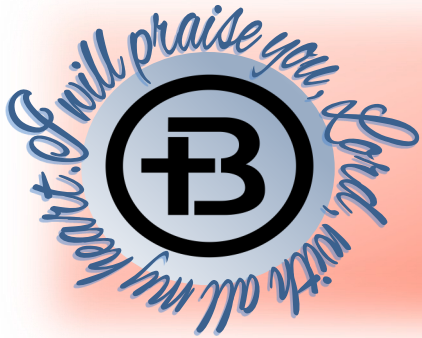

From The Pastor

How can a church guard against false teaching? 1 John addresses a growing movement of false teaching in the New Testament church. The Bible frequently warns churches to guard against false teaching (1 Tim 1:37). The church guards against false teaching primarily by believing and submitting to the truth that Scripture is our only authoritative word. Rather than waiting for false teaching to arise, we guard against it by regular commitment to Scripture. Churches should read Scripture together (1 Tim 4:13). Pastors should preach Scripture expositively (2 Tim 4:1-2). Christians should read Scripture, pray about it, meditate on it, and discuss it (Psa 119:9-16). Devotion to and elevation of Scripture protects a church from false teaching. - Jimmie

How to Be Saved

Man's Problem -- Sin

The Bible says that all have sinned. Sin is failing to honor and obey God.

Sin's Penalty -- Death

Everyone suffers this spiritual death. This death means to be cut off from a relationship with God now and forever.

God's Answer -- Jesus

Jesus, the sinless Son of God, became a man so that He could die in man's place and suffer punishment for his sin.

Man's Response -- Faith

Repentance is acknowledging one's sinfulness and need of salvation. Faith is believing that Jesus is God's Son and only answer for one's sin. It is trusting what He did through His death and resurrection to be the answer for one's sin.
